Quoting a play:

**If using No Fear Shakespeare, quote from the original side.*

(Act. scene. line)

(II. iii. 49-54)

II = Act 2 iii = scene 3 47-50 = lines 46-54

How it looks following a quote:

According to Lennox, “The night has been unruly. Where we lay, / Our chimneys were blown down and, as they say, / Lamentings heard i’ the’ air, strange screams of death, / And prophesying with accents terrible / Of dire combustion and confused events / New hatched to the woeful time” (II. iii. 49-54).

*Notice the / following the end of every line – this is required. Also, maintain capitalization as it appears in the original play.
